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

1 Connecting the CPE

- A) Remove the rear bottom panel.
 B) Connect one end of the Ethernet cable into the LAMPoE) port of the CPE and the other end to the PoE Pot on the PoE Adapter.
 C) Connect the Power cond to the PoE Adapter and plug the other end into an electrical outlet.
 D) Connect the second Ethernet cable into the LAMp ort of the PoE Adapter and the other end to the Ethernet Too thou the compouter.
 E) Place the panel removed from step A back into the device
- Note:

 The EnStations should ONLY be powered via Ethernet cable connected to included Proprietary PoE Adapter.

 For EnStation AC The 2nd Ethernet port of the EnStationAC can supply the 802.3af power source when used with the included PoE Adapter.





2 IP Address Configuration

B) If your Computer is already on a network, ensure that you have set it to a Static IP Address on the interface.

(Example: 192.168.1.10 and the Subnet Mask address as 255.255.255.0.



3 CPE Setup

A) To configure the CPE, open a web browser. In the address bar of the web browser, enter 192.168.1.1 and hit enter.





4 Switching Modes

- A) The device can operate in the following modes: Access Point, Client Bridge and WDS.
- B) Click on the Operation Mode link under the System Properties.






Wall Mounting the CPE

- A) Put the included rubber into the bracket.
- B) Plug the dynamic stick into the bracket.
- C) Screw the sealing nut and assembled parts, as well as tighten it.
 D) Put the nock washer on the dynamic stick.
 E) Assemble the mounting parts to the CPE.



F) Determine the mounting location. Mark and drill two pilot holes aligning to the screw holes of the bracket. O Put wall anknors into the holes and insert screw into the wall anchor. H) Screw and secure the bracket in place.




Pole Mounting the CPE

- A) Put the included rubber into the bracket.
 B) Plug the dynamic stick into the bracket.
 C) Screw the sealing nut and assembled parts, as well as tighten it.
 D) Put the notk washer on the dynamic stick.
 Assemble the mounting parts to the CPE.



F) Thread the open end of the pole strap through the two tabs on the bracket.
 G) Lock and tighten pole strap to secure bracket to the pole.




